APPLE CRISP

In Memory of Cindy Burner (Pg. 96)



1 C. Oatmeal

1 C. Flour 6 C. Sliced Apples

1 1/2 C. Brown Sugar (add salt & cinnamon to taste) 1

1/2 C. Sugar

1 C. Butter or Margarine

Combine oatmeal, flour, brown sugar, sugar and butter. Blend together until crumbly. Place apples in a 8x13 inch pan. Top with oatmeal mixture. Sprinkle with salt and cinnamon. Bake at 350 degrees for 40 minutes. Yield: 12 servings


